

Protection for mother & child

What method of contraception should you choose? Where can you go for check-ups during your pregnancy? How do make sure your child gets the right health checks? These are just some of the questions that Mother and Infant Protection (PMI) centres can answer.

What is Mother and Infant Protection?

The PMI service offers you a range of services through a network of **neighbourhood centres** at locations across the whole of Paris.

Twenty **family planning centres** are open to young women, couples and teenagers for information on relationships and sexuality, marriage advice, medical consultations for contraceptive prescriptions and screening and treatment for sexually transmitted infections.

Women without entitlement to welfare benefits, teenagers and adults who choose to keep their identity confidential can access our **services anonymously at no charge**.

The maternal protection service can organize free **pregnancy check-ups** in 11 accredited maternity hospitals and offers information and support to expectant mothers and fathers on all aspects of **having a baby**.

The infant protection service offers **free preventive medical check-ups** in 69 centres for children under the age of six, health education and screening programmes, and early-learning activities for children.

The PMI service also accredits, audits and monitors day-care facilities for young children, and childminders.

Based on a wide range of activities, the PMI service plays a part in offering parents information, support and guidance, thereby contributing to the overall Child Protection system.

PMI centres

From prenuptial advice to choosing a **registered childminder**, a multi-disciplinary team is on hand to help with everything that might affect the health of expectant mothers and children under the age of six, in 81 mother and infant advice centres.

Support in the child's first few years

Infant protection centres offer families in Paris access to free advice from a **paediatric nurse**, preventive medical check-ups, early-learning activities for children and parental and family support.

Support for pregnant women

Eleven maternity hospitals, approved by the Department of Paris, are available to you to provide easier access to care during your pregnancy and to entitlement to welfare benefits.

Support for parents of children with a disability or chronic illness

PMI centres provide advice and guidance to the parents of children suffering from a **disability** and/or chronic illness, in order to provide help and support for their care and/or integration.

Support for non Frenchspeaking families

Socio-cultural mediators and interpreters are available to help immigrant families who speak little or no French at their children's check-ups.

We have **interpreters** for numerous languages available either on a regular basis or on request for infant protection consultations.

Since 2001, seven arrondissements have set up a socio-cultural mediation service to help foreign families to understand and use the various healthcare and social services available to them.

Mediators familiar with your language and culture are on hand to help you at special surgeries at centres in the 10th, 11th, 13th, 17th, 18th, 19th and 20th arrondissements.
